Most of the rides were overnights and we stayed at a lot of lesser known spots which are some beautiful parts of this state. The same great feelings of new experiences and camaraderie in RV bring back those memories and none more so than the weekend at Pt Rickaby.

Pt Rickaby is a little seaside holiday village towards the bottom of Yorke Peninsula with a jetty, beautiful beach & coastline, serenity and coastal walks. The sandy beach is on the north side of the jetty and extends for several hundred metres until it changes to a rocky shoreline, the same as on the south side of the jetty. The beach itself has a gentle slope and is a safe beach for swimming or other water activities, with crystal clear water.

As per usual members of our group started arriving from Thursday and some didn't leave until the Monday. Again we had day-trippers visit us, with Tony arriving by motorbike on Saturday to join in for a while until he headed for home late afternoon. Also Fleurieu President Brett, and his wife Judy arrived Saturday afternoon to have two nights with the group at this fantastic spot, after spending a week at Wilpena Pound.

There was plenty to occupy us in this little village and surrounding area. People went fishing, swimming, walking, and touring the region, and when that got too much we sat in the shade enjoying the company of others. It was not possible to keep Barbie out of the water for her daily swims, even though she had unexpected company. On both Friday and Saturday she had an amazing experience with a reasonable sized stingray gliding beside her as she swam. When she told us of this experience it wasn't long before the bullshit started to flow – 'Did you see the Bronzie swimming behind the ray', 'Trying to do better than Steve Irwin' etc etc.

Well they didn't completely make the break, they still stayed in a cabin.

The Managers of this Caravan Park were excellent. They were always busy doing bits and pieces around the park to keep it neat and tidy, but still very social and having a cheerful word to you as they went about their business. And then on Saturday night as the 20 odd of us were having 'Happy Hour' in the Camp Kitchen they brought out trays of food that was more than enough to soak up the beverages we were consuming. From all accounts this is a regular occurrence when there is a reasonable number of people in the kitchen. A big thank you to them for this.

After having such a great time, in great company and discovering this hidden gem, many people were saying they have to go back to Pt Rickaby with a group or just by themselves.

Hello fellow RV'rs, from us in beautiful western Queensland. By the time that you read this, four States will have held rallies in February, and going by what I have read on the reports coming through to Judi, everyone had a great time. Getting together with like minded people, sharing a meal, having a few drinks, swapping stories, giving advice, sometimes helping out with repairs or sharing new ideas.

We have been jumping through hoops with the bank to get our club account up and running, but things are now progressing, and in the near future we will have a club account with the NAB with three signatories, namely Ken, Gordon and I. Gordon will have an Eftpos card with which to pay suppliers such as our shirt supplier and badge supplier, and as well we will have access to online banking to pay our various other suppliers or annual accounts. Sherol and I have not been travelling since arriving home in Chinchilla last November, concentrating on our renovations, and we now have a brand new modern kitchen, and other improvements. Our van, the Crusader Inspiration is up for sale, as we are looking at downsizing to a smaller van which we can utilise for weekend and shorter trips away.
